COURTCLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE is an environmentally responsible, non-ecotoxic, and biodegradable product. The neutral PH formula removes scuffmarks and residue from both waterborne and oil modified gym floors. It can be sprayed and wiped, wet moped using a microfiber mop, spray and buffed, or used in an autoscrubber. COURT CLEANZE™ dries quickly and doesn't leave watermarks, streaks, or residue when used properly. Dilute COURTCLEANZE™ with water (1:10) for daily cleaning and (1:5) for deep cleaning. NONFLAMMABLE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

MIXING - FOR DAILY CLEANING MIX 1 PART COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE TO 10 PARTS WATER. FOR DEEP CLEANING MIX 1 PART COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE TO 5 PARTS WATER. SEE DIRECTIONS BELOW:

CLEANING PADS: USE WHITE PADS ONLY WITH AUTOSCRUBBERS OR HEAVY DUTY FLOOR MACHINE (175 RPM).

COURT FLOOR CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

DO NOT USE ANY DUST MOP TREATMENTS ON YOUR FLOOR. IF DUST MOP TREATMENTS HAVE BEEN USED DEEP CLEAN USING AN AUTOSCRUBBER OR HEAVY DUTY FLOOR MACHINE FIRST.

It's important to implement an effective cleaning routine. Most court floors are used all day long and are often abused with street shoes, equipment, chairs, and tables. The dirt and grit that is tracked onto the court floor surface is very abrasive. If the dirt and grit is not picked up off the floor daily, your court floor will become dull and slippery. The court floor should be cleaned several times during the day to keep the dirt and grit off the floor. Keeping the dirt and grit off the floor will maintain gloss and traction for a much longer period of time.

Each facility will have a different cleaning schedule based on its court floor usage. But the standard rule of thumb is to dry mop the court floor after each activity. If this cleaning schedule cannot be achieved at your facility, the minimum should be to dry mop the floor in the morning, afternoon, and evening each day the court floor is being used.

STEP 1 - DRY CLEANING. Begin by removing all dust, dirt, and grit by tack and vacuum. It's important the floor is dust free before wet cleaning with COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE.

STEP 2 - WET CLEANING. The floor should be cleaned using a solution of COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE at the end of each day. Wet cleaning removes the fluids, sweat, and penetrating soils that dry mopping leaves behind. Wet cleaning with COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE also keeps the surface traction tight.

DAILY CLEANING WITH A COURT DUSTING TOOL - Use a COURT DUSTING TOOL with microfiber cleaning pad attachment. Mix COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE in a bucket of water. Remove microfiber cleaning pad and soak in cleaning solution. Ring out microfiber pad before tacking floor. DO NOT FLOOD THE FLOOR. As the microfiber cleaning pad becomes soiled it should be cleaned in the bucket of cleaning solution as often as needed to prevent streaking. Dirty floors may require additional buckets of cleaning solution. After the entire floor is cleaned wash the microfiber cleaning pad in clean water and allow to air dry. After several usages the microfiber cleaning pad should be laundered.

DEEP CLEANING USING A HEAVY DUTY FLOOR MACHINE - Use a heavy duty floor machine equipped with white pads. Spray or mop (DO NOT FLOOD THE FLOOR) a solution of COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE in front of the floor machine and buff with white pads. Buff in 2' x 25' sections. Remove the residue by tack using water dampened towels and/or squeegee vacuum. Complete one section at a time. Do not allow the cleaning solution to dry on the floor before it is removed by tack and/or squeegee vacuum or it may require buffing again. Clean or replace soiled white buffing pads as often as necessary to prevent streaking.

DEEP CLEANING USING AN AUTOSCRUBBER - Use an autoscrubber equipped with white pads. Fill tank with a solution of COURT CLEANZE™ COURT FLOOR CLEANER CONCENTRATE. Be sure the autoscrubber is picking up all the solution from floor. Any solution left on floor should be immediately tacked with microfiber cleaning pad or towel dampened with water. Clean or replace soiled white buffing pads as often as necessary to prevent streaking.
